
Hydraulic plant at Coulouvrenière-Rois

which uses water from the Rhone's currents to power the machines that drive Geneva's industry and trades, particularly the watchmaking workshops. At night, problems arose when the craftsmen stopped working and left an excess pressure buildup in the system. A safety valve was added to control the pressure, which created a jet of water, which became so popular that a second spout was added on the jetty at Eaux-Vives: Jet d'Eau.
