You go first!




What is this?

## **Snowmageddon 2015**

Snow summary for Scituate from *The Mariner*:

Jan 27, blizzard, 21.5 inches

Feb 2, 14 inches Feb 8-9, 18.8 inches

Subtotal: 54.3 inches (so far) Feb. 15-16, Neptune, 18-24 inches

Feb 24: showers, 5 inches Feb 26: showers, 4 inches

Boston, from *The Associated Press*: Boston's winter of 2015 is now also its snowiest season going back to 1872. The official measurement of 108.6 inches at Logan International Airport Sunday night topped a season record of 107.9 inches set in 1995-96, according to the National Weather Service in Taunton, Mass.

The final 2.9 inches came in a snowstorm that was relatively tame after a record-setting monthly snowfall of 64.9 inches in February.

The official winter snowfall, measured from December through February this year, is 99.4 inches.
